SET OF FACTS	PLANET
Easy to see without a telescope or binoculars.	
Has strong winds of 1 400 km/h.	
Planet was discovered on 23 rd September 1846.	
Called the 'ice giant'.	
Surface temperature is -145 °C.	
Has a light pink-brown colour.	
Has 14 moons.	
Takes 84 years to orbit the Sun.	
Has 62 moons.	
Mass is 318 times that of Earth.
